8am – 10am *Fire Instructor Update*

Division of EMS. The class will cover current certifications, CE requirements and live burn NFPA 1403 in pre-engineered facilities or acquired structures. 2 hours of Instructor or fire CE.

8am – 10am *Pediatric Emergencies*

This class will cover all medical aspects of pediatric EMS calls from onset to transport. 2 hours of EMS CE.

10am - Noon *Inspector CE*

This class will cover school inspections. assembly areas, bleachers, art rooms, corridor access and decorations on bulletin boards. Code requirements and lockdown drills. 2 hours of Inspector or fire CE

10am - Noon *Human Trafficking*

Understand the different types of trafficking, the visual behavioral cues to watch for, and what actions to take if you suspect trafficking. 2 hours of EMS CE
